- Designs and implements VSAT satellite communication systems based on appropriate principles, theories, methods and techniques.
- Ensures solutions exhibit high levels of performance, security, scalability, maintainability, and reusability.
- Supports the corporate Network Operations Center (NOC) in the provisioning, implementation, and monitoring, troubleshooting of VSAT and Network communications.
- Provides oversight of VSAT projects, including development of timetables, budgets, and status reports.
- Monitors VSAT satellite communication systems to ensure they are operating according to contractual service level agreements.
- Manages VSAT satellite communication systems to ensure they support corporate network architecture and operations.
- May consult with business unit contract operations and program management staff.
