As a Plumber we offer you the opportunity to work on substantive assignments to support deployed personnel, so they may concentrate on the mission. You will be responsible to perform work in support of all plumbing operations, maintenance, repair, and minor construction tasks in support of base facilities maintenance program.

Principal Accountabilities:

- Performs repairs on all plumbing equipment, plumbing systems, and components as directed and within applicable plumbing codes.
- Reads and interprets instructions and documentation and plans work activities
- Performs Preventive Maintenance (PM) inspection schedule for all plumbing equipment, plumbing systems, plumbing piping, infrastructure drainage systems to include all potable water, non-potable water production, storage, and distribution systems and components. Includes, as a minimum, septic systems and leach fields, where applicable.
- Moves materials and equipment to work locations and sets up work sites
- Assembles, installs, and repairs pipes, fittings, and fixtures of heating, water, and drainage systems in support of plant construction and maintenance activities
- Completes records, maintains tools and equipment, and performs various clean-up and housekeeping activities
- Locate and repair defective plumbing fixtures and pipe
- Services hot water heaters
- Performs other duties as assigned
- O&M Plumbing consisting of all materials and labor from the first valve and manhole to the building including all plumbing fixtures and piping contained within, and outside the building.

Knowledge & Skills:

Must possess working knowledge of the plumbing trade including the installation, repair and maintenance of hot and cold water lines, sewer pipe, soil pipe, traps and appliances such as water closets, lavatories, urinals, showers and tubs.

Must be able to follow blueprints, diagrams and engineering specifications.

Must possess working knowledge of plumbing fuel lines to include FARPs.

Must pass English proficiency test

Physical Requirements:

Living and working conditions at the assignment location could be remote and uncomfortable. Long hours, exposure to weather and hazardous conditions. Personnel should be aware of moving on short notice and under adverse conditions.

Experience:

Typically requires five (5) years experience in an apprenticeship or comparable training via technical school training or community college.

Education:

High School Diploma or equivalent. Completion of Plumbing Apprenticeship or a Two-year Technical school with certificate as Plumber.
